New, Solar Company Registration Requirements (March 2024)

The Planning and Development Services Department is continually working to improve the arlingtonpermits.com permitting process to provide a better customer service experience! We are introducing a new, **single**, Solar Company Registration Requirement. The new registration requirement allows Solar Companies to apply for a single Electrical Contractor registration.

When will this change take place? Starting **Friday, March 1, 2024**, anyone submitting Solar Panel permit applications will only need to apply for a **single** contractor registration called **Electrical Contractor Registration**. This enhancement removes the need to apply for two separate registrations.

What contractor registration do I need to apply for the Solar Panel permit? You are required to have an active **Electrical Contractor** business (contractor) registration with the Planning and Development Services Department.

How can I find out if I have the correct active, contractor registrations? One way to find out if your registrations are active with city is to go to arlingtonpermits.com to perform a contractor search. **Click on Search** at the top of the page. Click on **Search for a Contractor**. Type in the Contractor (Company) Name, then select from the drop-down list **Electrical Contractor**, then click on **Search**. The search results will only list “**Active**” Contractors. If your company name does not appear on the list, then you will have to create a new contractor registration. The other way to find out if your registrations are active is to log in to your arlingtonpermits.com to check your registrations under the **My Services** page. Scroll down to the **My License and Registration** section of the page to find the status of your contractor registrations.
