AGE GROUP PROGRAMME

The FIG Age-Group Programme involves intense practical coach training camps that include physical conditioning and technical preparation training, and multi-level competition programmes (exercises). It is a programme that helps federations to have ready-made resources to develop their own programme. It can be organized for one FIG affiliate member and/or combined with neighbouring countries.

FIG experts will work with local gymnasts to conduct effective practical sessions with participant coaches.

ACADEMY PROGRAMME

The FIG Academy Programme is a coach education programme available to all FIG affiliate members' coaches in all disciplines, delivered in a hydrid format, including on-line theory lectures and face-to-face practical sessions in three languages (English, French and Spanish). The mission of the FIG Academy programme is a result of an assessment of knowledge of coaches at the level appropriate to their competence. The programme has an introductory course titled "Foundations of Gymnastics" and three-level courses for each FIG official competitive discipline, with participants from multiple countries and teaching by renowned international experts. A Certificate is awarded for participants that succeed in the Theory Exam (online) and a Diploma to those that succeed after the Practical Exam.
