THE OPENING KICK

The Ohio football team (9-3, 6-2 MAC) is set to take on Georgia Southern (6-6, 3-5 SBC) in the Myrtle Beach Bowl on Dec. 16. Kickoff is set for 11:00 AM ET at Brooks Stadium in Conway, S.C. The game can be seen on ESPN with Drew Carter, Dustin Fox, and Stormy Buonantony on the call

The Bobcats' matchup can also be heard on the Ohio Sports Network from Learfield. Russ Eisenstein returns for his 16th season as the "Voice of the Bobcats" and will be joined by Rob Cornelius, who has been a part of the broadcasts for two decades.

SERIES HISTORY VS. GEORGIA SOUTHERN

The Myrtle Beach Bowl will be the first time the Bobcats and Eagles have faced each other.

The Bobcats hold a record of 34-28-6 against Sun Belt competition. Excluding games played against Marshall, Ohio is 1-7 in games against Sun Belt foes.

Georgia Southern is 5-2 against Mid-American Conference opponents. This is the second consecutive year the Eagles will play a MAC program in a bowl game. Last year, Georgia Southern lost to Buffalo in the Camellia Bowl.

SCOUTING GEORGIA SOUTHERN

The Eagles enter the matchup with a 6-6 record and were 3-5 in conference play. In their last game on the road at Appalachian State, the Eagles lost 55-27 (Nov. 25).

On the season, Georgia Southern averages 30.9 points per game while picking up 298.5 yards per game through the air and 124.3 on the ground.

Senior running back Jalen White led the way for the Eagles on the ground. He ran for 891 yards and nine touchdowns while averaging 5.6 yards per carry. The senior also added 65 receiving yards and a touchdown through the air. White had four games with over 100-yards rushing on the year, including a career-high 164 yards against UL-Monroe. Sophomore running back OJ Arnold added 405 yards and four touchdowns in a complimentary role.

Quarterback Davis Brin threw for 3,418 yards and 22 touchdowns this season. Brin, a transfer from Tulsa,

MAC East Special Teams Player of the Week

Jack Wilson (Oct. 23) Jack Wilson (Nov. 27) had a season-high 383 yards in the Eagles' loss to Wisconsin. Averaging 285.9 yards per game, Brin led the Sun Belt in passing yards. Brin is tied with Colorado State's Brayden Fowler-Nicolosi for the most interceptions thrown in the country with 16.

Brin's top receiving targets include Khaleb Hood, Derwin Burgess Jr., Dalen Cobb, and Jjay Mcafee. Hood was the leading receiver for Georgia Southern. The fifth-year senior caught 94 passes for 917 yards and five scores. Burgess Jr. Made 68 catches for 696 yards and added five touchdowns for the Eagles. Cobb had 33 catches, 492 yards, and two touchdowns. Tight end Jjay Mcafee made 32 catches for 316 yards and added three touchdowns.

On the defensive side of the ball, Marques Watson-Trent was the leading tackler with 117. He made 56 solo tackles, had 13 tackles for loss, 3.5 sacks, and two interceptions. He was selected to the Sun Belt's All-Conference First Team for his strong season. Defensive tackle Justin Rhodes was a key contributor for the Eagles, making 12 tackles for loss and 30 tackles. Defensive end Isaac Walker led the team in sacks with six. He also forced five fumbles, the most of any Sun Belt player. The Eagles were led in interceptions by defensive back TJ Smith (3) and in pass deflections by Shemar Bartholomew (13).

Kicker Michael Lantz was 23-for-28 for field goal attempts on the season with a long of 48. From inside of 40-yards, Mantz was 17 of 18. He was also perfect on his point after attempts, going 42-for-42. Punter Alex Smith averaged 40.2 yards on 45 punts. He had a long of 58 and had 18 punts downed inside the 20-yard line. DeAndre Buchannon was the leading kick returner for the Eagles. He had 19 returns for

525 yards, averaging 27.6 yards per return. He also had one touchdown on a 100-yard kick return. Khaleb Hood was the team's punt returner. He made 25 returns for 191 yards.

LAST TIME OUT

Highlighted by quarterback Kurtis Rourke becoming the second leading passer in program history, the Ohio football team (9-3, 6-2 MAC) wrapped up the 2023 season with a 25-14 victory over the Akron Zips (2-10, 1-7 MAC).

Rourke finished the day 19-for-30 with one passing touchdown on 208 yards. When claiming the No. 2 spot among all-time passers, Rourke passed his brother, Nathan Rourke, who recorded 7457 from 2017-19.

Junior wide receiver Miles Cross scored the sole passing touchdown of the game and lead the receivers with seven receptions on 103 yards. Redshirt senior Tyler Foster recorded four receptions while graduate student wide receiver Sam Wiglusz had three catches on 30 yards.

On the ground, redshirt sophomore running back Sieh Bangura and Rourke each scored one touchdown. Bangura led the rushers with 121 net yards and 23 attempts while Rourke had nine carries on 10 yards.

Graduate student linebacker Bryce Houston led the defense with six tackles—including three solo stops—and one interception. Redshirt sophomore cornerback Torrie Cox Jr. graduate student linebacker Keye Thompson recorded five tackles each.

Kicker Gianni Spetic kicked a 26-yard field goal on the opening drive, giving the Bobcats an early 3-0 lead. Akron answered in the second

Al-bin No-WIN-skee ISS-furr-DING Truh-MAYNE FAWN-ess quarter, wrapping up a 66-yard drive with a 43-yard passing touchdown, putting Ohio at a four-point deficit. With 1:50 remaining in the half, another Akron touchdown put the score at 14-3.

Rourke scored Ohio's first touchdown of the day with 8:20 left in the third quarter. The graduate student followed with a successful two-point conversion to redshirt fifth year wide receiver Tyler Walton, cutting the Zips' lead to 14-11. Their next drive, Ohio reclaimed the lead with a one-yard passing touchdown to Cross. After Spetic's successful extra point, the Zips trailed by four

Houston cut Akron's next drive short, snagging the ball less than a minute into the drive. The Bobcats proceeded to open the final 15 minutes of play with a 15-play, 64-yard drive that culminated with a rushing touchdown by Bangura. After Spetic's successful PAT, Ohio extended their lead to 25-14.

The Bobcats' defense held the Zips for the rest of the game, allowing Ohio's offense to reclaim possession for the final drive of the game. Rourke took a knee as the Bobcats went into victory formation, solidifying their 25-14 victory over the Akron Zips to close the regular season.

SCOUTING OHIO

The Bobcats are 9-3 overall and 5-2 in MAC play. They average 22.92 points per game on 137.1 rushing yards and 210.58 passing yards per game.

In the air, Parker Navarro is 7-for-10 on 248 yards, throwing two touchdowns and one interception in five games. Navarro is also a threat on the ground with 10 carries for 107 yards. Navarro also has the longest rush for the Bobcats this season with a 52-yard scamper against Kent State.

Running backs Nolan McCormick, Rickey Hunt, and Quintell Quinn will carry the load for the Bobcats. McCormick has recorded 83 carries for 289 yards and a touchdown. Hunt has six carries for 19 yards while Quinn has five for 22. McCormick also has 20 receptions for 164 yards and a touchdown in his career.

Running backs Sieh Bangura and O'Shaan Allison lead the Bobcats on the ground. Bangura has a team-best seven rushing touchdowns on 811 yards and 178 carries while Allison is right behind him with 139 carries and three touchdowns on 452 yards. Bangura has also tallied one receiving touchdown on 18 receptions.

Wide receiver Sam Wiglusz has recorded three touchdowns on 51 receptions and

596 yards. The graduate student was selected to the All-MAC First Team for the second consecutive season. Tight ends Will Kacmarek and Tyler Foster have proven to be a strong tandem. Kacmarek has 22 receptions for 243 and a pair of touchdowns. Foster has made 19 catches for 202 yards on the year. Freshman Chase Hendricks also played a role for Ohio, making eight catches for 83 yards.

Defensively, linebacker Bryce Houston leads the team with 119 total tackles and 54 solo stops, putting him fourth in the MAC and 16th in FBS football. He's also recorded 2.5 sacks, three interceptions and four quarterback hurries. Defensive end Vonnie Watkins has a team-best 10 quarterback hurries while defensive tackle Rayyan Buell, Houston, and defensive end Bradley Weaver are all in the top 10 of the MAC in tackles for loss. Houston has 12.5, Buell has 11.5 while Weaver is just behind with 10.

Kicker Gianni Spetic is 16-for-24 on field goals and 28-for-29 on PATs while kicker Alex Kasee is 1-for-2 on field goals, 2-for-2 on PATs and has accumulated 3,341 yards in 60 kickoffs. Punters Jack Wilson and Jared Wheatley have both made appearances this season, with Wilson's longest of 26 clocking in at 58 yards while Wheatley has 19 punts on the season, averaging 36.79 yards per punt.

SIX BOBCATS EARN 2023 ALL-MAC ACCOLADES

After wrapping up their second consecutive nine-win regular season, six Ohio football student-athletes earned All-Mid-American Conference recognition.

Three of the Bobcats' five captains earned All-MAC First Team accolades. Graduate student wide receiver Sam Wiglusz represents the team on All-MAC First Team Offense while graduate student linebackers Bryce Houston and Keye Thompson were named to the All-MAC First Team Defense squad.

Graduate student quarterback Kurtis Rourke is the only representative on the All-MAC Second Team while graduate student defensive end Vonnie Watkins and redshirt senior defensive tackle Rayyan Buell earned All-MAC Third Team Defense recognition.

WATCH OUT FOR WIGZ

Wide receiver Sam Wiglusz had a recordsetting day last Saturday (Oct. 21) against Western Michigan. He recorded a personalbest 155 receiving yards, passing the previous record he set against Akron during the 2022 season (144 yards). He scored his only touchdown of the day with 4:36 left on the clock, extending Ohio's lead to 10 points and allowing the Bobcats' to maintain a tight



lead when the Broncos scored the following drive. On the day, Wiglusz finished with a team-leading 10 catches.

Nationally, he recorded the third-highest receiving yards in all of college football, trailing Ohio State's Marvin Harrison Jr. (162) and Washington State's Lincoln Victor (161). Wiglusz was the only Group of 5 athlete to make the top five, finishing ahead of Utah's Sione Vaki and UNC's Devontez Walker.

DOMINANT DEFENSE

With opposing offenses averaging just 15.42 points and 264.4 yards per game, Ohio's defense leads the MAC and is No. 4 in FBS football. Individually, linebacker Bryce Houston is ranked 16th in FBS football in total tackles (119).

Currently, there are three Bobcats in the top 10 in tackles for loss in the MAC— defensive tackle Rayyan Buell, defensive end Bradley Weaver and Houston. Buell and Houston have 11.5 each while Thompson and Weaver are just behind with 10.

The Bobcats' defense was lights out in Boca Raton. As a team, they held the Owls to five rushing yards, averaging only 0.3 yards per attempt. The next week, they held Power 5 opponent lowa State to just seven points, keeping them scoreless into the fourth quarter. Against Bowling Green, the defense held the Falcons to 206 yards, averaging only 3.8 yards per attempt.

During their Homecoming game, the Bobcats' defense held Kent State to 17 points on 228 yards of total offense. The next time on the Frank, Ohio defense held WMU to their lowest number of rushing yards so far this season (79). During their first midweek game of the season, the Bobcats' defense held the Bulls to three points in the first half and 10 total

Ohio's defense remained strong in the final two games of the regular season. The Bobcats limited Central Michigan to 20 points and forced two turnovers. In the regular season finale, Ohio held Akron to just 183 total yards and 14 points. The Bobcats did not give up a point in the second half while Houston caught his third interception of the season.

MYRTLE BEACH BOWL HISTORY

The Myrtle Beach Bowl is a newer addition to college football's roster; its creation was announced in 2018 and the inaugural matchup was in 2021. The game features three conference partners: Conference USA, Mid-American Conference, and the Sun Belt Conference. Notably, the Myrtle Beach Bowl is the first of its kind for South Carolina, owning the "first college bowl game in South Carolina" proudly. Since its inception, the game has been played at Coastal Carolina's

Brooks Stadium.

BOBCATS MAKING HISTORY

For the first time in program history, Ohio has recorded nine-win regular seasons in back-to-back years. The Bobcats won nine regular season games a year ago, going 7-1 in conference play.

The Bobcats will look to get their tenth win of the year against Georgia Southern. Achieving the tenth win would give the Bobcats their first consecutive ten-win seasons and the fifth time the Bobcats have had ten wins in a season.

HOUSTON IS AN CFN ALL-AMERICAN

After a stellar 2023 season, graduate student linebacker Bryce Houston earned College Football Network Third-Team All-American Defense accolades. He represented the Bobcats on CFN's All-MAC Defense Team and the Linebacker of the Year.

Houston (Lewis Center, Ohio) leads the defense in total tackles (119) and is currently ranked 16th among all NCAA FBS athletes. On the season, he's recorded a team-best solo tackles (54), assisted tackles (65), tackles for loss (12.5) and interceptions (3). In the MAC, Houston is fourth in total tackles and third in tackles for loss. The linebacker earned First-Team All-MAC Defense honors and was named MAC East Defensive of the Week accolades twice this season.

BOBCATS THRIVING UNDER ALBIN

In his two seasons at the helm of the Ohio football program, head coach Tim Albin has led the Bobcats to back-to-back nine-win regular seasons and two consecutive bowl games. The Bobcats defeated Wyoming in the Barstool Sports Arizona Bowl 30-27 in the 2022 season.

The Bobcats last recorded consecutive bowl appearances from 2015 to 2019 under former head coach Frank Solich. Ohio also has won its last four bowl games dating back to the 2017 Bahamas Bowl in which the Bobcats defeated UAB 41-6.

BROYLES AWARD NOMINEE NOWINSKY

Defensive coordinator Spence Nowinsky was named a nominee for the Broyles Award for the 2023 season. The Broyles Award was created in 1996 recognizing Coach Frank Broyles' legacy of selecting and developing great assistants duriang his hall of fame career as head coach at Arkansas.

Under Nowinsky's guidance, Ohio's defense leads the MAC and is ranked fourth in FBS football, holding opponent offenses to 15.42 points and 264.4 yards per game. So far this season, the Bobcats' defense held FAU to five rushing yards (Sept. 9), Power 5 opponent Iowa State (Sept. 16) to just seven points and kept Western Michigan (Oct. 21)

to 79 rushing yards, marking their lowest of the season.

FAANES RECEIVES RECOGNITION

Special teams coordinator and linebackers coach Nate Faanes was named to the American Football Coaches Association 35 Under 35 list. The AFCA 35 Under 35 Coaches' Leadership Institute is a program created to train premier, future leadership in the football coaching profession.

Faanes has been a member of the Bobcats' coaching staff since 2016, starting his tenure as a defensive graduate assistant before becoming the linebackers coach. In 2020, Faanes added Special Teams Coordinator to his responsibilities. In his time as an assistant at Ohio Faanes has coached numerous All-MAC selections, highlighted by 2023 All-MAC First Team selection Bryce Houston.

BOBCATS IN THE CFL

Three former Bobcats are currently active in the CFL. Defensive tackle **Casey Sayles** is with the Hamilton Tiger-Cats. Tuggle previously played for the Ottawa RedBlacks, signing with the Tiger-Cats on Nov. 1.

Running back **AJ Ouellette** plays for the Toronto Argonauts, who are the 109th Grey Cup Champions. Sayles, who was a member of the Winnipeg Blue Bombers at the time, competed in the same Grey Cup. Both Sayles and Ouellette were named 2023 CFL Division All-Stars

While with the BC Lions, **Nathan Rourke** was named Most Outstanding Canadian (Nov. 17, 2022). He is the first BC Lions' quarterback and the third quarterback in CFL history to earn the honor. Ohio football alumnus **Chip Cox** is apart of the 2022 CFL Hall of Fame class, earning the honor in his first year of eligibility. Cox played 13 seasons for the Montreal Alouettes, wrapping up his career with the fourth highest total defensive tackles in CFL history (979).

BOBCATS IN THE NFL

Multiple former Ohio football student-athletes are representing the Bobcats at the highest level of the sport.

QB Nathan Rourke signed to the Jacksonville Jaguars' practice squad after playing in multiple preseason games. On Oct. 18, Rourke was promoted to the Jaguar's active roster. After signing as an undrafted free agent in April 2022, former Ohio quarterback Armani Rogers made the Washington Commanders' 53-man roster as a tight end (Aug. 30, 2022). OL Austen Pleasants was signed to the Los Angeles Chargers' practice squad on Nov. 9, 2022. He signed a reserve/futures contract in Jan. 2023. As of Aug. 30, he is on their practice squad.

Tim Albin was named the head football coach at Ohio on July 14, 2021

The 2023 squad finished the regular season with a 9-3 record, marking the first time Ohio football finished consecutive regular seasons with nine wins. Notably, Ohio defeated lowa State 10-7 at home (Sept. 16) to mark its first Power Five win since 2017 during a five-game winning streak. Later in the season, their 34-20 victory over Central Michigan marked the first time since 2011 the Bobcats defeated the Chippewas and the first time they won this matchup at home since 2000.

The 2022 football team finished the season as MAC East (7-1) and Arizona Bowl Champions with a 10-4 record, marking its first 10-win season since 2011 and the second-best turnaround in FBS football last year. The Bobcats were also undefeated at home, posting a 6-0 record on Frank Solich Field at Peden Stadium, and wrapped up the regular season with a seven-game winning streak.

This performance earned Albin MAC Coach of the Year honors, quarterback Kurtis Rourke MAC Offensive Player of the Year honors as well as the Vern Smith Leadership Award and running back Sieh Bangura MAC Freshman of the Year accolades.

Since his arrival in Athens, Albin has produced offensive units that have consistently ranked among the top of the Mid-American Conference. He also has directed an offensive attack that has practically rewritten all of Ohio's rushing, passing records, and scoring records. In the past 10 seasons, Albin's offensive units rank No. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 on the Ohio all-time Top 10 single season scoring list. The Bobcats 368 points in 2016 rank fourth on the all-time list.

In 2016, the Bobcats had the most pass attempts (458) and second-most compltetions (250) in school history. THe offense totaled 5,492 yards of total offense which is third all-time at Ohio. The Bobcats also compiled the second-most pass yards in school history (3,142) and the fourth most touchdown passes (22).

In 2015, the offense totaled 5,378 yards, which ranks third all-time in program history. The Bobcat quarterbacks passed for 3,026 yards, which ranks third all-time in program history as well.

In 2014, the offense totaled 4,443 yards of offense which ranked fifth all-time in program history. The combination of Derrius Vick and JD Sprague proved to be dynamic through the air as the quarterbacks combined to pass for 2,474 yards for the season which is sixth all-time in program history.

The Bobcat offense found a balanced attacked with AJ Ouellette in the backfield. The freshman ran for 785 yards ranking him only behind Kareem Wilson for most yards on the ground for a freshman.

In 2013, under Albin's watchful eye, Ohio's offensive attack averaged 379.4 yards per game and surpassed 400 yards of total offense in seven games during the 2013 campaign. The Bobcats closed the year with 4,932 yards of total offense. The 2013 campaign also marked the final season of Ohio's most prolific offensive trio in school history as quarterback Tyler Tettleton, running back Beau Blankenship and wide Donte' Foster all concluded their respective collegiate careers.

Albin recruited all three players and all three players flourished in his offensive scheme. At the end of their respective careers, Tettleton, Blankenship and Foster accounted for over 25,000 yards of total offense and 128 touchdowns.

Tettleton finished his career at Ohio with 27 school records and once again passed for over 2,500 yards through the air. He is the only quarterback in school history to pass for over 2,500 yards in three-consecutive seasons.

Blankenship closed his senior campaign with 910 yards rushing and five touchdowns. He finished his career fifth on the all-time rushing list with 2,976 yards.

Foster concluded his senior campaign with his best single-season of his career as he finished with 1,018 yards receiving and seven touchdowns. The Guthrie, Okla., native became just the second wide receiver in school history to surpass 1,000 yards receiving. He also finished his career with the most all-time touchdown receptions (21). Following the year, Foster was selected to the All-MAC Second Team.

In 2012, Albin's offensive unit that accounted for 5,782 yards. In fact, Ohio was one of just four teams in the Mid-American Conference to post 5,500-yards or more of total offense in 2012 (Northern Illinois, Ball State and Toledo). Ohio had seven games in which it surpassed 450 yards of total offense.

Albin's offensive unit played a major role in Ohio's 45-14 victory in the Advocare V100 Independence Bowl. In the win, the Bobcats' 556 yards of total offense served as an Independence Bowl record, while their 45 points tied the Bowl record. Following the game, Blankenship and Tettleton were named Co-Offensive Most Valuable Players of the Independence Bowl.

Ohio's 2012 offensive unit averaged over 30 points per game for the second straight season and the third time in the last six years. In addition, the Bobcats scored 40-or-more points in four different games.

The 2012 campaign also saw Blankenship rush for a single-season school record 1,604 yards and 15 touchdowns. He became the eighth running back in school history to rush for over 1,000 yards in a single season. Following the year, Blankenship was named All-MAC Second Team. Offensive lineman Skyler Allen



and Eric Herman joined Blankenship on the All-MAC Second Team. Since taking over as offensive coordinator in 2005, Albin has coached 26 All-MAC players and All-Americans LaVon Brazill (2009) and Joe Flading (2011).

Tettleton once again posted a memorable season under Albin's direction as he passed for 2,844 yards and 18 touchdowns, while throwing just four interceptions in 12 games.

In April of 2013, Herman became the third offensive player to be selected in the NFL Draft over the last four years as he was drafted by the New York Giants in the seventh round.

In 2011, Albin's offensive scheme led to the most prolific year in school history. Ohio set eight team single-season offensive records, posting school standards for most yards gained (6,241), most passing yards gained (3,482), most offensive plays (1,026), average yards per game (445.8), passing attempts (429), most points scored (427), most passing completions (276) and most passing yards per game (248.7).

Under Albin's watchful eye, Tettleton re-wrote the Bobcats' single season record book in his first-year as a starting quarterback as he set 12 school standards, while becoming the first signal caller in program history to throw for over 3,000 yards. In addition, Tettleton accounted for 38 total touchdowns (28 passing and 10 rushing) and nearly 4,000 yards of total offense (3,960) en route to being named All-MAC Third Team.

The 2011 Ohio offensive unit also produced record-breaking performances from Brazill and Donte' Harden as the two combined to set eight single-season records. Brazill would go on to finish his career as the program's all-time leader for receiving yards (2,511) and receptions (189).

At the end of the year, a league-best six Bobcats were named to the MAC's All-League team on the offensive side of the ball.

In April of 2012, Brazill was selected in the sixth round of the NFL Draft by the Indianapolis Colts.

In 2010, Boo Jackson finished his career as Ohio's career leader in completion percentage (.604), pass efficiency (136.3), total offense per play (6.18), passing yards per attempt (7.7) and touchdown passes (38). He also finished the season responsible for 26 touchdowns, 48 in his career, which is fourth all-time, and with 18 passing touchdowns in 2010 (fourth all-time on the single-season list).

Ohio also had the best red zone efficiency among all MAC teams in 2010, converting 88.4 percent of its tries inside the 20-yard line. The Bobcats converted 38 times on 43 occasions, scoring 38 touchdowns and five field goals. Ohio was also outstanding at running the football, finishing second in the conference with 1,416 yards on the ground (177.0 per game average) for the 2010 season and 19 touchdowns.

In 2009, Albin's offense took aim at more of Ohio's all-time marks. Quarterback Theo Scott threw 20 touchdown passes, which stood as a school record until the 2011 season, while receiver Terrence McCrae tied Andrew Mooney's then single-season touchdown

reception mark of nine.

The 2009 team also finished with passing yards (2,774), completions (228) and total offense (4,342) all of which rank among the program's top five all-time marks.

Albin mentored running back Kalvin McRae who earned first-team All-MAC honors in 2005, 2006 and 2007. McRae is the first Bobcat in history to crack the 1,000-yard mark in three straight seasons. Under Albin's tutelage, McRae rushed for 4,398 yards and 45 touchdowns. McRae owns the second, fourth and sixth-highest single-season rushing totals in school history after setting the single-season rushing, touchdown and points scored records.

Albin spent the 2004 season as offensive coordinator and running backs coach at North Dakota State, helping the Bison to an 8-3 record and No. 25 national ranking in their first season at the Division I-AA level. NDSU finished the season averaging 378.5 yards of total offense, including 192.4 on the ground, and had four offensive players named first-team All-Great West Football Conference.

Albin served with Solich at Nebraska from 2000 to 2003. He started with the Cornhusker program as a graduate assistant, a position he held for three seasons before being promoted to running backs coach and passing game coordinator for the 2003 season. Working with the Nebraska tight ends as a graduate assistant, Albin helped Tracey Wistrom earn third-team All-America status in back-to-back seasons.

Prior to his stint at Nebraska, Albin was the head coach at Northwestern Oklahoma State for three seasons, winning the NAIA national championship in 1999 with a 13-0 record. He was named NAIA Football Coach of the Year by Rawlings and American Football Coach Magazine as the Rangers recorded their first undefeated season in history. Six of his players earned NAIA All-America honors. Albin's three squads improved every season going from 5-5 in 1997 to 7-3 in 1998.

Returning to his alma mater in 1994, Albin served as Northwestern Oklahoma State's offensive coordinator and head men's and women's cross country and track and field coach prior to his promotion to head coach of the football program.

He earned Oklahoma Intercollegiate Conference Coach of the Year honors twice for his work with the men's track program, leading them to back-to-back league titles. Albin got his start in coaching at Northeastern State (Okla.) in 1989 where he won two conference titles as an assistant football coach and two more as head of the men's track program.

As a player, Albin was a first-team All-Oklahoma Intercollegiate Conference selection as a wide receiver in each of his final three seasons as a member of the Northwestern Oklahoma State squad. He added to those honors by becoming the first Rangers' player to earn All-District IX status three times.

Albin received His bachelor's of science in business administration from Northwestern Oklahoma State in 1989 and a master's of science from Northeastern State in 1991. A native of Woodward, Okla., Albin was born on Sept. 13, 1965. He and his wife, Brooke, have two children - daughter Tori, and son Treyce.
