### Content of this message:

- Adjustment of Stop Trading Range for Equities of SMIM®
  - Publication of the revised Trading Parameters Guideline which enters into force on 1 May 2019
- 

This message from SIX Swiss Exchange AG is to inform participants about the publication of revised rules in connection with the adjustment of the Stop Trading Range in the trading segment “Mid-/Small-Cap Shares” for securities of the Swiss Market Index Mid (SMIM®) as of 1 May 2019.

The stop trading range for the delay in the opening or the trade interruption for securities of the Swiss Market Index Mid (SMIM®) in the trading segment “Mid-/Small-Cap Shares” will be changed in the Trading Parameters Guideline from currently 1.5% to 2%. The duration of the delay in the opening or the trade interruption remains unchanged at five Minutes. With this adjustment a discrepancy between the Trading Parameters Guideline and the Trading Guides is removed. The regulation is therefore consistent with the effective handling of SIX Swiss Exchange AG.

### Trading Parameters Guideline

The Trading Parameters Guideline of SIX Swiss Exchange has been amended to take into account the revocation of the duty to trade on the Exchange. The revised Trading Parameters Guideline comes into force on 1 May 2019 and can be downloaded from the SIX Swiss Exchange website via the following link:
